1. Kind of application

2. Personal details

Your personal information will only be used by ARTCEB for internal use and to keep you informed of the activities by the centre.

3. Discipline

Mark the box of your discipline. This is important to ARTCEB for planning purposes so that the preferred diversity of disciplines, experience and backgrounds can be obtained. ARTCEB categorises participants as visual artist, performer, sculptor, ceramist, designer, painter, and others.

4. Education / experience

A brief explanation of motivation and / or plans concerning the residency in relation to present work plus a visual print or drawing to support your plan. Only when applying for the Residency for Young Participants: two written references are required.

7b Images

ARTCEB prefers to receive **digital images**:

- Max. 10 images are required.
- The images must clearly show a development over the past 3 to 4 years
- Preferably images of individual works, but no more than 3 views / details per work.
- The files must be in JPEG-format (maximum 800 x 600 pixels)
- The title of the digital images must contain your surname, the year and a number in chronological order (for example: Wens 2012_01.jpg) corresponding to the image list (starting with the most recent work)

For Mac-users:

- The images must be MS Windows compatible (use ISO 9660 standard or a hybrid format)
